The second powerful statement is ...the Holy One of Israel... It is not referring to the king, the prophets or a well behave personality in Israel. The Holy One of Israel is God Himself that wipes off the iniquity of

Israel. Each time these words is rendered, it thus proved some points, they are *I am their righteousness. *It's not wrong if it is my words. *it's my wisdom *it's my way *it's my thought.
